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**Title of the proposed track:** *Student-Focused Research: Using student insights to shape the next generation of responsible leaders.*

**Track description:** The "Student-Focused Research" track explores innovative, student-centered approaches in education for developing responsible leaders. Workshops will cover gathering student insights, integrating them into curriculum design, fostering ethical leadership through student initiatives, leveraging technology for feedback, creating inclusive environments, aligning education with industry needs, and measuring the impact of student-informed programs. Experiential learning exercises, like simulations, will allow participants to role-play and problem-solve in scenarios about moral dilemmas, collective action, post-apocalyptic survival, and information asymmetry. The track emphasizes transformative pedagogy, encouraging collaboration, critical reflection, and adapting to the dynamic nature of ethical challenges.
